## **PLAYER COMMITMENT AGREEMENT**

Thank you for choosing SA FIRE Soccer Club. We are a nonprofit organization that strives to live by our core values: Sportsmanship, Attitude, Fun, Integrity, Respect and Effort.

To help make the 2011-2012 SA FIRE tryout experience more efficient, please review the following Commitment Agreement prior to tryouts.

### **Overview:**

At tryouts, players are required to check in and complete a player information sheet. Players will be given a tryout number at check-in to help with assessing the player's skills and effort. **A place on the team is not guaranteed.**

For players who accept a position with SA FIRE, a non-refundable \$75 commitment fee will be due by June 15. The fee can be paid by check – payable to *SA FIRE Soccer Club*, or by PayPal, located on the SA FIRE Web site.

### **Registration:**

Players who register as a member of the SA FIRE Soccer Club will remain on the team for the 2011-2012 soccer year. I understand this commitment is from June 15, 2011 through May 31, 2012. I understand the selection and team placement of players will be at the SA FIRE Soccer Club coaching staff's discretion.

Player participation is dependent on the player and family adhering to the rules, agreements and Parental Code of Conduct and Contract, located on the SA FIRE Web site. I will also follow the policies and rules of these organizations to stay in good standing with the SA FIRE Soccer Club: the North East Youth Soccer Organization (NEYSO), Western District Division One Association (WDDOA), the South Texas Youth Soccer Association (STYSA), the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) and US Club Soccer.

A player cannot play for more than one team, Recreational or Select, except where the club pass rule is permitted. Any player rostered to a team can only play for the team they are assigned to, from Aug. 1, 2011 through May 31, 2012, unless the parent completes and submits a *STYSA player release form*.

The SA FIRE Web site will include the most up-to-date information, including access to our team calendar. This site will be the primary source for general information, such as important dates and tournament details.

**Parent Contract:**

The 2011-2012 SA FIRE Soccer Club Parental Code of Conduct and Contract can be found online at [www.safiresoccer.com/forms](http://www.safiresoccer.com/forms). All players and their families are expected to follow and support the policies and procedures of the organization. Please let your team coach or organization director know if you have any questions.

**Expectations and Requirements:**

SA FIRE is committed to each player for the entire year; the organization expects each parent and player will demonstrate the same commitment.

When placed on the roster, each player commits to being at all games and practices unless they are unable to play due to illness, injury, family emergency, or other special circumstance.

The coaches will make every effort to provide quality playing time for all players, although there are *no* guarantees of playing time for any of our competitive teams. The coaches will attempt to play each player at least one-half of every game, except when players are sick, injured or for disciplinary reasons. Each player should plan to play in several tournaments on holiday weekends, including Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day, and possibly others.

**Required Uniform Fees:**

All players are required to purchase the uniform package, which will be used for two years, 2011 and 2012 soccer seasons. Payment of \$100 will be due by June 15, which will help cover the deposit charges for the uniform order. The remaining balance will be due by July 15.

**Refund Policy**

Refunds will not be issued after June 15, when the season starts, as other players may have been turned away due to your acceptance to play for the SA FIRE Soccer Club.
